

Sergeant First Class Harvey L. Liberman Memorial Scholarship Fund

2002 Application

This fund will award one \$500.00 scholarship to the best-qualified candidate who files this application by 22 March 2002.

To be eligible to apply for this scholarship you must be a member of the Massachusetts National Guard, dependent spouse, son, or daughter of a deceased, retired, or current member in good standing of the Massachusetts National Guard. Previous winners are not eligible to apply.

Officers, Warrant Officers, and Enlisted soldiers and airmen are encouraged to apply. This scholarship is designed to award exemplary citizenship, not just excellent grades in academics.

Applicant must be enrolled in the second or subsequent semester of a post secondary institution. (I.e. accredited trade school, or college, or university. ITT Tech is given an equal weight as a Masters or Bachelors program)

Instructions:

- Submit two letters of recommendation from individuals who can describe and attest to your demonstrated citizenship and patriotism. They should be in sealed envelopes with your package.
- Submit one page that lists your extra curricular activities and awards.
- Submit an essay on:
“Your view of the use of Military Tribunals to prosecute terrorists” (Keep to 1 page or less).
- Submit proof of attending an above listed post-secondary program (Official Transcript).
- Submit this completed personal data sheet together with the above listed items as a package. Incomplete applications will not be processed.
